
No hat not play including excursions.

Children to bring own sunscreen




All children attending excursions are to be 5 years old and completed 1 term of school. Fees must be paid before bookings can be made. **All booking and cancellations must be made on FullyBooked.** Any cancellations after this is an Allowable Absence charge. A \$10 absent fee per child will be added if no communication is made about attendance. **No phone bookings acceptable.** Meal deal money must be paid with booking. No money will be accepted on the day. All staff have basic knowledge of first aid, are aware of requirements and obligations of Child Safe Environments and Safe Food Handling procedures. All activities link to all 5 outcomes of the My Time Our Place document. All National Quality Areas are followed as part of the National Quality Framework.
