
No hat not play including excursions.

All children attending are to be 5 years old and completed 1 term of school. Fees must be paid before bookings can be made. **All booking and cancellations must be made on FullyBooked.** A \$10 administration fee per child will be added if booking not cancelled prior to 7am. **No phone bookings acceptable.** Meal deal money must be paid with booking. No money will be accepted on the day. No spending money. All staff have basic knowledge of first aid, are aware of requirements and obligations of Child Safe Environments and Safe Food Handling procedures. All activities link to all 5 outcomes of the My Time Our Place document. All National Quality Areas are followed as part of the National Quality Framework.
